**Podemos** is a political party and social movement, launched just 3 months before the European elections, in which it won the support of over **1.2 million voters** carrying the voice of the people into the European Parliament with **5 MEPs**. It has also become the **third political force** in Spain with regards to affiliation numbers, with over 100,000 members registered in less than 20 days. Podemos is currently engaged in a constituent process concluding with a **Public Assembly** where the fundamental points of this **new way of doing politics** are to be settled.
